

Parliament march on 15/11/2010.

The Parliament march organized by JAC was conducted on 15/11/2010. Nearly 1200 comrades participated in the march from all over the country in which nearly 250 comrades from NFTE-BSNL enthusiastically participated. After the march at Jantar Mantar a meeting was organized in which all leaders of JAC including Com. Chandeswar Singh, General Secretary NFTE-BSNL spoke on the demands for the 3 day's strike from 1st to 3rd December 2010. A memorandum on the demands was also submitted to the officer of special duty at the PM's office. We must conduct a campaign on the demands for the strike in Dec-2010.

But unfortunately the BSNLEU wants to disrupt the JAC to have advantage in the ensuing 5th Membership verification. In the official web site of BSNLEU there was a negative reporting on the participation of NFTE BSNL in Monday's march to parliament. The unity of JAC is paramount to all of us to defeat the privatization/ disinvestment and retrenchment policies of the govt. But BSNLEU seems to be much worried about 5th Membership verification than the united strike in Dec-2010. We would like to question the General Secretary of BSNLEU to publish the number of participants from each union/ association in JAC so that every employee/ executive will know the truth. It is childish to criticize NFTE-BSNL for the poor mobilization of employees /executives to the parliament march on 15/11/2010. Let BSNLEU first see its face in the mirror.
